<i>Remarks:</i>	Entries in the database are indexed according to all pertinent bibliographical parameters (authors, titles, dates, place of publication, journals and series names, reviews, key words and phrases, etc.) In addition, each entry is indexed by a number of discrete subject headings which are the basis for locating specific subjects and contexts in the literature. At present, there are no plans to make the bibliography available to work in the Apple Operating System or on the Apple Computer platform. However, ASCII Text files of the database could be provided for importing into flat-file databases in the Apple environment. However, a version of the database might be made available for searching on the World Wide Web. A paper-edition would also be published with detailed lists of cross-references and concordances to permit full manual searching. This bibliographical database is still a work in progress. Completion is estimated in two years. In the hopes of eliciting comments and feedback from scholars, a copy of the current working draft of the bibliography - in paper format and searchable only by author and subject headings - can be ordered from the editor.
